This is to remind you of a serious financial risk to you as a tenant. As a condition of your lease, you are required to carry adequate insurance coverage. If you do not currently have insurance, you are risking a large financial loss in the event of an accident....even if it's not your fault.

The landlord's insurance covers the building itself, not tenant's possessions, your landlord would not be responsible to:

- a) Replace any of your property that has been damaged
- b) Provide alternate accommodations if your suite is inhabitable
- c) Cover any costs, such as meals, time off work, etc.
